

Call for Applications - Post of Research Officer, MCAST University College for project titled *MicroWatts (Micro Wastewater Treatment System using Photocatalytic Surfaces)* under the INTERREG V-A Italia-Malta Programme.

1. Applications are invited for a full-time Research Officer on a three-year definite contract to work on the MicroWatts project, which is financed by the Interreg V-A Italia-Malta Programme. The Research Officer may also be required to work on other projects undertaken by the University College, MCAST.
2. Applicants must be in possession of a first degree or a Master's degree in Environmental Engineering or a significantly related programme. Previous experience in project management and applied research will be considered an asset.
3. The chosen candidate shall be funded to read for a Masters by Research at MCAST that will relate to the research theme in question.
4. Candidates should submit their letter of application, a copy of their curriculum vitae, copies of their certificates and transcripts. Applications should be received by not later than Thursday 12th July 2018. Late applications will not be considered.

 - a) Produce deliverables and related reports within the stipulated time frames as shall be specified;
 - b) Keep detailed project reports and abide to all the conditions imposed by the project;
 - c) Assist in the dissemination process with the Maltese stakeholders via workshops/seminars as required by the project;
 - d) Travel and attend meetings/conferences as the need arises;
 - e) Gather data related to the project within the designated study area;
 - f) Perform any other project related tasks as instructed by the project leader and key experts.
 - g) Work effectively in a team environment.
 - h) Assist in generating technical and scientific conference/journal papers.
