




## **Job Description**

Main Objective	To research various areas related to educational challenges with the aim of improving student engagement and achievement

- 1. To plan and carry out research in various educational areas including challenges and barriers encountered by students, curriculum and profiling;
- 2. To carry out educational research, providing design expertise and measurement tools in close collaboration with technical experts;
- 3. To design and carry out quantitative and qualitative research throughout all the stages, to reach the aims of the project;
- 4. To prepare literature reviews;
- 5. To develop research methodologies that will target the aim for which the research is being carried out;
- 6. To recruit participants and contact them as necessary;
- 7. To collect, analyse and interpret data and develop innovative strategies informed by the findings, to develop tools, resources, pedagogies that will enhance student's learning journeys;
- 8. To guide research assistants throughout the research process;
- 9. To analyse data and prepare reports on project results;
- 10. To prepare articles, reports and presentations as necessary, including regular reports on work being carried out;
- 11. To track progress over time, compile data for progress reports;
- 12. To prepare regular reports on work being carried out;
- 13. To develop evaluation tools and evaluate implementation of strategies;
- 14. To work closely, in collaboration with other researchers and technical experts, supervised by Head of Foundation College;
- 15. To work in liaison with relevant MCAST units and departments as necessary;
