DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1 To actively scan the local and international environment, gathering information and competitive intelligence on innovative learning technologies and methodologies.
- 2 To identify technologies and methodologies that can be leveraged to improve teaching and learning efficiencies within the MCAST vocational environment.
- 3 To map and identify dynamic student trends and behaviours towards innovative learning technologies and methodologies, in order to preempt and prepare MCAST for new methods of education.
- 4 To create a localized environment that allows for prototyping and testing of innovative technologies and methodologies.
- 5 To map and identify socio-economic shifts that may relate to possible new student markets.
- 6 To set up effective external linkages, technological collaboration, strategic learning methodologies, thus creating a culture of open innovation and promoting knowledge-sharing circuits and networks.

- 7 To identify and promote a strategic vision for the use of innovative learning technologies and methodologies, such that MCAST educators would have access to the appropriate tools for 21st century learning.
- 8 To play a significant role in the dissemination of innovation findings, presenting at conferences and contributing to publications.
- 9 To nurture new thinking and ideas from concept through pilot, supporting the introduction into mainstream activity and working to counteract resistance to innovation.
- 10 To work closely with colleagues and key staff for the building of a culture that is conducive to that of an innovative mindset.
- 11 To agree personal performance targets with the Deputy Principal Research and Innovation.
- 12 To demonstrate a personal commitment to the MCAST mission, integrity, equity and value systems, including team work and continuous professional improvement.
- 13 To assist staff in their needs, including resources, CPD and professional assistance related to their tasks. To provide regular staff evaluations.
- 14 To convene regular and formalized meetings with colleagues and key staff.
- 15 To help build a campus environment that promotes a sense of belonging amongst staff and students.
