- 1. Assess students' psychological, learning and emotional needs
- 2. Develop and apply effective interventions to promote psychological wellbeing, social, emotional and behavioural development, and to raise educational standards
- Consult and liaise with the Wellbeing Hub team and other multi-agency teams to advise on the best approaches and provisions to support learning and holistic development
- 4. Design and develop projects involving students
- 5. Following assessments and consultations, reports are created which include diagnosis and recommendations on the way forward
- 6. Working within inter-disciplinary teams where and when necessary
- 7. Attend case conferences involving multidisciplinary teams on how best to meet the social, emotional, behavioural and learning needs of the students
- 8. Support guardians, lecturers and other support staff involved with the education and emotional wellbeing of students
- 9. To conduct active research
- 10. Liaising with services and institutes within MCAST and with other organisations and services outside of MCAST
- 11. To organise outreach activities and contribute through continuous professional development to other staff members
- 12. Participating in continuous professional development programmes, supervision and team meetings organised by the Department Student Support Services
