The selected candidate shall work on the following areas:

1. Contribution towards the design and the delivery of educational content on Ocean Literacy
2. Contribution towards research on the status of MSP-related policy in Malta and the Mediterranean

For both work streams the candidate will carry out the following tasks under the guidance of the Applied Research and Innovation Centre (ARIC):
